WORK TO BEGIN ON ODEON HALL:

After many months of planning the contractors are starting on the Odeon Hall addition/renovation. Outside work has begun with the digging in of a larger water service and the footings for the addition.

All inside work will not begin until after Feb. 1, 2012. The Odeon Hall will be unavailable for use for approximately 3 months.

The City received word that they were awarded a grant in the amount of \$29,534 from the MN Historical Society for a portion of the work to be done within the original building.

Very positive feedback was received from the Grant's Review Committee regarding the current project and the past preservation efforts of our small community.

PARKVIEW HOME PROGRESS:

In a recent letter sent to Parkview Home residents, families and staff from Parkview Home Administrator Jim Broich, he noted that restoration work has begun inside the building.
