## **CURFEW TO BE ENFORCED:**

School is almost out and the City Council would like to remind parents of the City's Curfew Ordinance which will be enforced. Chapter 15.101 of the Belview City Ordinance states that it shall be unlawful for any person under the age of 16 to remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or public places in the City of Belview at night after 10:00 p.m. unless such person is accompanied by parent, guardian, or other person having the legal custody of such minor person, or is in the performance of an errand or duty directed by such parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody of such minor person, or whose employment makes it necessary to be on the said street, alleys or public places during the night, or during school activities or special events, during the night time after said specified hours.

The Redwood County Sheriff's Department is aware of the City's ordinance and will be enforcing it.
