The City Council of the City of Belview met for the regular monthly meeting on June 9, 2009, at the Community Center, Belview, MN at 6:30 p.m..

Mayor Sander called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.. The consent agenda was approved by a motion from Dianne Donner and was seconded by Linda Sullivan. Carried.

City Clerk Lori Ryer gave a report on the elevator situation. It was noted that the owner of the property had been given a 90 day notice to fix the property up or demolish it. It was noted that the owner has until the end of July, 2009 to comply.

A letter from the city attorney to a resident regarding the notice of a public nuisance was reviewed. The property owner was give 30 days to comply.

The City Council ratified the new hire of Bill Marhoun as a volunteer firefighter on the fire department.

Discussion on installing new doors and painting of community center was tabled until the June meeting.

FEMA grant information for a new fire hall was received. The fire chief will research it further. It is 100% grant no match required.

The council agreed to have the community center painted. It was suggested to check with Redwood County Recycling Center to see if they have enough paint of a decent color to do the job.

The City Council postponed the appointment of two Parkview Board Members until the July meeting.

The sick and vacation report was reviewed

David Diekmann gave the Council a copy of his maintenance report for the month. He discussed replacing the fencing at the ball field. He will get prices for the next meeting. He will also check on prices on agg lime for the in-field.

David reported the MN Rural Water was out and televised the sewer line between 2nd and 3rd Street. They suggested getting someone to come in and cut the tree roots out. The Council agreed that this is to be a top priority.

It was suggested to have a sign made that donations will be accepted for the mini golf.

David was asked to blade alleys.

The Council stressed the importance of keeping a list of projects for the summer worker to take care of. They felt that it was important to take advantage of the help when we have it.

Linda gave a report on Parkview/Parkwood Apartments. She said that after the trees were “trimmed” they are now going to be removed. They will then hire Buckley’s to plant appropriate sized trees.

The Council agreed to plant a dozen trees in town this summer. The City will also work with Buckley’s to plant the appropriate type of boulevard trees.

A building permit from Gordon Pederson was presented for a 52x18 shed. The permit was approved by a motion from Janet Anderson and was seconded by Linda Sullivan.

Linda Sullivan made a motion which was seconded by Dianne Donner to adjourn.
