The Belview City Council met for their regular monthly meeting on November 13, 2007, at the Belview Community Center, at 6:30 p.m..

A written report from Ervin Well was reviewed. Ervin Well also provided the council with a videotape of the interior of the well that they worked on.

A copy of a yearly contract with Ervin was also reviewed. Bruce Gryting made a motion to approve the contract and it was seconded by Linda Sullivan.

Odeon Roof is in need of repair. It is leaking in a couple of spots. David will look at it and if he can't do anything he will contact a roofer. The city is also looking at getting a price on making the bathrooms in the Odeon handicapped accessible. There is a MN Historical Society grant that would help with the expenses.

The elevator property was discussed. Contacts will be made again. The property is falling into disrepair and has been the target of vandels.

A request made by Rita Donner to wash her ECHO school bus in the fire hall with the pressure washer was declined.

The sample of a tree policy which was received from the DNR was reviewed. It was found to be too restrictive for the size of town we have and will be redone.

Janet Anderson made a motion which was seconded by Doug Arnold to approve the contract with Nester and Nester for 2008.

A request for a \$200 donation to the Booster Club from the Cans For Kids was approved from a motion by Janet Anderson and was seconded by Linda Sullivan. Carried. The Council requested that the funds be used for the children.

A draft of an application for use of the Community Center/Odeon Hall was reviewed. It will be revised at the December meeting.

The Sick and Vacation report was reviewed.

Linda Sullivan gave a report on Parkview/Parkwood.

Lori Ryer reported that she is learning the payroll system at Parkview to be a backup for Wende Hustad in the event that she is gone.

Bruce Gryting made a motion which was seconded by Linda Sullivan to adjourn.
